Spot child find red flags

ONE-PAGER: Stay alert for signs and information indicating that a student may have disabilities and need **special ed**ucation and rehabilitative services.

Blurred lines: Understand how ACEs impact eligibility, child find to avoid missteps

Students who have faced adverse childhood experiences may also have an IDEA eligible disability, but it's not always immediately evident. Learn some factors to consider in the referral process to guide testing, ways to be mindful of the student's history when assessing, and proactive steps to prevent delays.
